



## Digitalis x Isoplexis

### Hybrid

The real breeding breakthrough is unlike digitalis, which bloom for a few weeks, digiplexis flowers for several months. Flowering begins in the mid spring and continues throughout the summer and until the first hard frost. Digiplexis grows numerous spikes with, as its name implies, flame colored sterile blossoms.
