



## Geranium Savannah Series

*Pelargonium x hortorum*

Savannah Geraniums feature bold balls of lightly-scented pink flowers with rose overtones and white eyes at the ends of the stems from late spring to early fall. The flowers are excellent for cutting. Its tomentose round palmate leaves remain green in color with prominent brown stripes throughout the year. The fruit is not ornamentally significant.
