The very compact habit of Floramia allows for less tangling on the bench, less invasion of other pots and overall easier to manage in production. Works well as an understory or accent plant with other annuals or even perennials.

Water: Moderately moist, mild dry cycles

Pinching: Yes, 7-14 days after transplant

Container Sizes 4", 6", 8"
