### General

**Media:** Well-drained, loose-filled  
**pH:** 5.6-6.2  
**Fertilization:** 150-200 ppm N  
**Light:** 5,000-9,000 fc  
**Water:** Allow soil to dry moderately

### Finishing

**Growing Temp Day:** 60-75 F  
**Growing Temp Night:** 45-55 F  
**Pinching:** After transplant  
**Container Sizes** 4", 6", 8"

## Crop Timing from Rooted Liners:

**4-inch:** 10-13 weeks

**8-inch:** 12-15 weeks
