Rudbeckia hirta

Rudbeckia hirta flowers continuously throughout the growing season which is a breakthrough for cultivars of this species which are normally long-day or summer flowering mainly. Its compact, well-branched, naturally rounded habit lends this cultivar to use as low-maintenance traffic-stopping specimen containers or add it to the garden and landscape for a riot of color from spring to fall.
