Media: Loose-filled, Well-drained

pH: 5.8-6.2

Fertilization: 200-250 ppm N, 20-10-20

Light: Part Sun-Part Shade

Water: Moderate, allow to dry completely

Growing Temp Day: 70-80 F

Growing Temp Night: 64-68 F

Pinching: Yes, once rooted to prop cell

Container Sizes 4", 6", 8", 10"
